Tesunho Network Walkie Talkie Fact Sheet



Mobile Data Network Walkie Talkie Radios

The revolutionary Tesunho mobile data network walkie-talkie radios allow long-distance, even nationwide, unlimited range walkie-talkie operation, anywhere that there is mobile phone network coverage.

Unlike normal walkie-talkies which transmit directly from one radio to another directly, giving a range of at best a couple of miles, these radios communicate by sending digitised voice data via the mobile phone data network.

Each Tesunho radio requires a SIM card like a mobile phone, with mobile data.

When buying these radios from us, we do not provide this SIM card. It makes more sense for the radio's user to set up a suitable mobile data SIM-only deal – there are many available for all the UK mobile phone networks.

The radios do not actually make mobile phone calls when you use them. Instead they communicate by sending mobile data. This allows near-instant walkie-talkie usage over the UK mobile phone network.

We supply two models of network walkie-talkie radio

The Tesunho network walkie-talkies need a mobile data SIM card to operate.

There is also an annual network access fee to pay to us to allow them to communicate across our network.

Users can configure their network radios into different user groups as needed.

These radios will work anywhere provided that they are in mobile phone reception.

This means that they are ideal for use across a town or city, for example, where mobile phone signals are generally good, but where conventional radio signals will not get very far due to obstructing buildings etc.

They will not work at all in areas where there is no or very low-quality mobile network signals. So they are not a good idea for use at, for example, music festivals or other events held “in the middle of nowhere”.

Also not ideal in places (again, think festivals or other very crowded events) where the mobile networks are likely to be overwhelmed by many more people than usual all trying to phone, text and use their mobile internet.

The TH289 walkie-talkie provides basic, unlimited-range digital network walkie-talkie functionality.

Both the TH289 and the TH388 have GPS functionality allowing the user of the “Dispatcher” software to view the radio’s location on Google Maps.

The more advanced TH388 walkie-talkie radio has a display screen allowing the user to set various options on the radio.

The display also allows text messages to be sent to the radio using the PC “Dispatcher” software. Each radio requires the user to provide a mobile data SIM card in order to operate.

Pricing

We sell you the actual walkie-talkie radios outright.

The Tesunho TH289 costs £160 + VAT each, or £150 + VAT each if five or more are bought together.

The Tesunho TH388 costs £230 + VAT each, or £220 + VAT each if five or more are bought together.

There is an annual fee to use the network software, without which the radios will not communicate, which is £30 + VAT per radio per annum.

The buyer must also provide their own mobile data SIM card, whether on a monthly contract or Pay As You Go.

These typically shouldn’t cost more than around £10 or so per month.
