The CPS Telecom CP183 is our smallest radio, weighing only 65 grammes.

It is also "licence-free" (PMR446).



The Amherst A66 weighs 160g.

It is more powerful than the CP183 (3 watts) and its use in the UK requires a basic licence.

Being more powerful, its signal can travel further through walls and floors inside a building.
